FLORIDA JOBS REPORT

I had the opportunity to be a part of several events this month with Governor Scott that highlighted businesses and announced thousands of new jobs for the State of Florida. I am happy to report that Florida's unemployment rate has dropped 2.3 percentage points – more than any other state in the nation! Over 130,000 private sector jobs have been added since December 2010. Prior to 2010, Florida had the second highest increase in the nation in unemployment. The policies recently implemented by the Florida legislature, and under the leadership of Governor Scott, has combated this issue head on, creating a more business-friendly atmosphere and encouraging businesses to grow in our state. Our goals of shrinking the size of government and holding it accountable, reducing wasteful spending, lowering taxes and eliminating burdensome regulation to make government more efficient has created and will continue to create positive change. I commend Governor Scott for being a strong leader and firmly believe that we are back on the path of prosperity!

JOBS ANNOUNCEMENT FOR SPACE COAST

Governor Scott's recent jobs announcement at Cape Canaveral provides just one example of positive job growth in our region. The "Strategic Weapons System Ashore" is a new facility made possible by Space Florida's \$5 million in capital improvements. The facility creates an anticipated 100 jobs with average annual salaries of \$90,000. This will benefit many, allowing the US
